### **No Smoking / vaping Policy.**

- It is the policy of Little Stars that the premises and the outside play area will be smoke / vape free.
- This policy has been developed to protect all employees, children and visitors from exposure to smoke and assist in the compliance of the Health Act 2006.
- Smoking /vaping is prohibited in all areas of the premises and this policy applies to all employees, contractors, customers, and visitors.
- Appropriate 'No Smoking' signs will be clearly displayed at the entrance to and within the premises.
- There are designated smoking areas /shelters around campus and must be used.
- Disciplinary procedures will be followed if a member of staff fails to comply with this policy and those persons who fail to comply with the smoke free law of 2007 may be liable to a fixed penalty fine and possible criminal prosecution.
