## *What is forced marriage?*

Forced marriage is a marriage performed without the full and free consent of one or both parties. Emotional, financial, physical and sexual threats and abuse, as well as notions of 'honour', can all be used to force someone to marry. Forced marriage can lead to physical violence, rape and even murder.
