What is PREVENT?

PREVENT aims to counter terrorism or violent extremism.

There are many reasons why people become involved with terrorism or extremism. Here are just some: a lack of identity or belonging, insecurity, defending their culture, way of life or beliefs, they may be pressured, or bullied into it, they may have been radicalised by violent extremist groups; they may want retaliation.

Those who encourage or get others to commit acts of violent extremism often target vulnerable people who are led into believing that violence or criminality can earn respect, riches or even glory. However, even though a person may feel angry about something they believe is unfair this does not mean they should attack or threaten any person or community.
