



SAFEGUARDING STALKING

What is stalking?

This is a pattern of abusive behaviour designed to incite fear and curtail freedom, such as watching or monitoring someone or forcing contact with them through any means (including social media).

Young women can be particularly at risk of stalking as college and social media can provide a backdrop of monitoring and surveillance which others can easily abuse.
