## What is harmful sexual behaviour?

Harmful sexual behaviour includes using sexually explicit words and phrases, inappropriate touching, using sexual violence or threats and/or full penetrative sex with other children or adults.

Young people who develop harmful sexual behaviour harm themselves and others.
