

SAFEGUARDING SEXUAL HARASSMENT/ BULLYING



What is sexual harassment/bullying?

This can be verbal (making indecent remarks about someone's appearance, sexual orientation or sex life or making requests/demands for sexual favour) or non-verbal (staring, sending indecent messages) or physical (touching, pinching, 'groping' or sexual assault).

It can be a one-off incident or a persistent pattern of behaviour and can occur anywhere.
